suppose it some of Ed Parr's talk
up there. by the way if you see him

you can tell him that he has been
masked absent without leave ever
since his term went out which was
Apr 28th I think that he had better
stay where he is and go to school
and not to trouble himself about
this war if he stays there no
one will ever trouble themselves
about sending for him for a boy
that will tell his as bad as he
will is not wanted in Co. A. 36th
you spoke about my forgetting the
children I assure you that I have
done no such thing for I would
like to see them very well especi-
ally the little meat man with his

cart. I was going to bring him
up a hobby horse if I had
got a furbergh. but as I did not
get one & could not send one very
well I gave it up but when I do
come if ever I do I will bring
him and the rest of the little
fellas some thing nice
I will get my photographs
to morrow and will send them
soon I have a couple of Ambrotypes
in a case that I will send with
this We received orders right after
parade to cook 5 days rations
& to put in our haversacks and
two in boxes this is all.

W^h dont Norris write I have
written once to him and he has
not written to me yet
