### **Internet Use Policy for Online Federal Government Information**

The same principle of free access that applies to the use of traditional depository materials, as stipulated in Section 1911 of Title 44, United States Code, also applies to online Federal Government Information provided through the Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP).

The Government Documents Department makes available to University patrons and the general public in-house computer workstations that provide access to federal government Internet resources. Use or access may be mediated or unmediated. This access is provided free of fees or other restrictions such as age or residency status; however, use of the workstations is subject to the library's Internet Use Policy.
