Serve as the Government Documents Librarian, with responsibility for the Government Documents Department, which includes both United States and Florida documents. Oversee a physical collection of close to 350,000 items. Provide in-depth government documents reference service, using electronic resources such as Internet, DVD, and CD-ROM, as well as traditional print and microform sources. Administer the Documents Program in accordance with Title 44 U.S.C. and the *Legal Requirements & Program Regulations of the Federal Depository Library Program* from the Government Printing Office.

Evaluate and select materials in all, but increasingly electronic, formats for inclusion in the documents collection, in accordance with the written Government Documents Department collection development policy. Submit item selection updates to the Government Printing Office to maintain currency and appropriateness of the federal documents collection. Follow Government Printing Office guidelines for weeding and disposal of federal documents.

Coordinate with the Catalog Librarian on government documents processing and cataloging and to ensure that Government Printing Office policies and procedures are being followed in the daily operation of the depository program and in special projects for the Documents Department.

Develop short- and long-range plans for the Government Documents Department, including budget, space, and equipment needs and projections. Prepare written planning documents, including an annual report, and present them to the Head of Public Services and the Dean of the Library & Digital Learning Resources, as required.

Participate in weekly and occasional week-end reference activities, such as answering questions and assisting with research through the on-call research librarian service, via telephone, and via email queries. Assist patrons in the use of computer, print, and microformat resources and in locating library materials. Research specific queries posed by students, faculty, staff, and administration.

Provide bibliographic instruction as requested by the Coordinator of Library Instruction and classroom faculty. Prepare research guides and handouts for instruction sessions.

As a member of the library's faculty, provide input into the development of library policies, procedures, and planning documents

Contribute to collection development activities by identifying and selecting materials to add to the Library's general collection.

Current research interests: electronic FDLP, the availability of online U.S. Congressional documents, electronic delivery of library instruction, and online reference resources.
