

Videotaping or Filming in the Library

The duPont-Ball Library provides an atmosphere conducive to teaching, learning, innovation, and research. As such, unauthorized video recording is strictly prohibited in the library. The filming of library spaces, faculty, staff, and students is not permitted.

Any non-commercial video recording in the library requires prior special approval from library administration. Any video recording for commercial purposes must be approved by the Stetson University Office of University Marketing.

The library reserves the right to terminate any photography, videotaping, or recording that is unapproved, contrary to the library's mission, causes a disturbance, violates library or university policies, or endangers the health and safety of participants, library users, or library staff. Any individuals refusing to stop recording upon request by authorized library personnel will be considered in violation of library policy and referred to Stetson Public Safety.
